1. Technical Guidelines for Uploading Abstracts

For Example:

Title: Calibri, 11 pt, bold. Titles should be written in “Capitalize Each Word” case (conjunctions are not capitalized, and only the species names are italicized).

Abstract (Calibri, 11 pt, bold for title/ Calibri, 9 pt, bold for in-text)

It is important to write ORCID ID information of the authors. Surnames of the authors must be In this template, **1st International Congress on Biotech Studies (ICBIOS)** formatting requirements are described. Make sure your e-mail address is correct, the Congress Secretariat will use this e-mail address to contact you. The abstract should be maximum 300 words. Font should be Calibri, font size 9 pt. Page Margins: Top, bottom, left and right margins must be set to 2.5 cm. Line spacing must be single. All abstracts should be written as *.doc or *.docx format. The Word File name should be written as Name_Surname. It should be submitted to **online submission system** of congress website.

Keywords: Calibri, 9 pt, bold, the first letter of title is capitalized. Provide 3 to 5 key words. (Use commas to separate words)

2. Technical Guidelines for Uploading e-Posters

Format: e-Poster presentation files will be accepted in PDF format only.

The size of your e-Poster presentation should not exceed 50 MB.

Fonts: Do not use special fonts which are not part of the standard PowerPoint package.

File name: The name of the presentation file should include the presenter's name and the abstract reference number. To avoid any compatibility problems, please do not use special characters (e.g. «, Ö, Ø, ñ, ε, ®, ý, }, {, etc.) to name your presentation.

Do not use any passwords or encryption for your presentation.

The regular poster size is 70 cm (width) x 90 cm (height) with vertical version.

Acknowledgements

Keywords: Calibri, 9 pt, bold, the first letter of title is capitalized. Provide 3 to 5 key words. (Use commas to separate words)

ABSTRACT: (11 pt, Bold) (Not exceed 200 words in research papers, 300 words in reviews)

The text of the abstract will be written in Calibri font size 9 pt. and in A4 format using Microsoft Word. The sheet margins will be: 2.5 cm for right and left margins and 2.5 cm for superior and inferior margins.

INTRODUCTION (11 pt, Bold)

The titles of the chapters will be written in capital letters font size 11 pt. Bold. The text will be written in Calibri font size 10 pt.

MATERIALS AND METHODS (11 pt, Bold)

The text will be written in Calibri font size 10 pt.

Figures in the paper have to be in the centre of the sheet. Text in pictures has to be written in Calibri font size 9 pt. A figure will be enumerated with a number and its name will be written under the picture in the centre of the sheet as shown in the example.

In case of having tables in the paper, the text in the tables will also be written in Calibri font size 9 pt. A table also has to be enumerated and its name will be written above the table, as shown in the example.

The uploaded figures should be at least 300 dpi.

RESULTS & DISCUSSION (11 pt, Bold)

The text will be written in Calibri font size 10 pt. In the papers that report experimental work, 'Results' and 'Discussion' sections are best combined; however, sections may be subdivided by further headings if the authors think that it is better in this way for the continuity in the discussion section. In case of separation, simply state what are found in the results section, but do not interpret them.

CONCLUSION (Calibri, 11 pt, Bold)

The text will be written in Calibri font size 10 pt.

Papers must not exceed 20 manuscript pages, including tables and figures. Papers have to be composed of the conventional chapters (Abstract, Keywords, Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results&Discussion, Conclusion, References). Please, follow the instructions for writing papers. Papers sent after the deadline will not be taken into consideration.

Only papers presented at the Conference will be published in the Book of Proceedings after review.

The text will be written in Calibri font size 9 pt.
